Tanenbaum held its fourth annual Religious Diversity Leadership Summit (the Summit) on June 19, 2019, tackling the theme of *Innovating Religious Diversity in the Workplace*. Programming kicked off with a keynote address from Ted Childs, followed by Tanenbaum's Learning Lab and a presentation on demographic information and trends by Pew Research. Panel discussions addressed the evolution of interfaith/faith-based ERGs and the intersection of religious and LGBTQ identities. The full-day event convened representatives from over 40 companies.

2019 Peacemakers in Action Working Retreat



Once every two to three years, Tanenbaum facilitates a week-long retreat for **Tanenbaum's Peacemakers in Action** — a Network of 28 men and women from 23 conflict zones who are motivated by their spiritual beliefs and practices to work across different faiths, cultures and countries in pursuit of global peace. *Peacemakers* live and work in the following countries: Afghanistan, Bosnia, Colombia, D.R. Congo, El Salvador, Ethiopia, Indonesia, Iraq, Israel/Palestine, Kosovo, Nigeria, Northern Ireland, Pakistan, Philippines, Sierra Leone, South Africa, Sri Lanka, South Sudan, Syria, Timor-Leste, Uganda, West Papua, and Yemen. Connections with many of these countries can also be found through Tanenbaum's work with Corporate Members and clients in their international offices.

This year's retreat will be held at the Stony Point Retreat Center from July 27 through August 2. The **Working Retreat** provides needed space for community building, training in areas such as trauma healing, and peace planning for some of the world's most intractable conflicts.

Similar to the impact that mentorship in the workplace can have on the career development of newer employees, the 2019 Working Retreat will include an effort to engage a new generation of peacemakers in the vocation of religiously-motivated peacebuilding. Current *Peacemakers* have nominated younger colleagues (or "mentees") to join them at the Working Retreat, where they will explore lessons drawn from the *Peacemakers in Action Network* and build critical connections to people and resources that can deepen their efforts for peace.


