A Resource for “White Supremacy”

1. What is the most surprising thing you learned from the White Supremacy resource?
 - a. Which groups of people were you surprised to find out have been targeted by white supremacist groups?
2. What are some reasons (especially those that are not “ideological”) that make white supremacy appealing to vulnerable individuals? Can you name some positive ways to address the needs of vulnerable individuals?
3. What are the 5 basic beliefs that different white supremacy movements share?
4. How is the Alt-Right movement different from/related to white supremacy and white nationalism?
5. Find a recent news article that mentions the Alt-Right. What does the article say about the Alt-Right’s beliefs or ideology? Does the reporter portray the Alt-Right according to the definition on the resource sheet? What makes you think yes or no?
6. Choose one white supremacy movement, and consider the viewpoints and motivations it purports. What data can you find to counter its beliefs? How did you verify the accuracy of your data?
