On February 13th, 2019, Tanenbaum and the Religious Freedom & Business Foundation launched the **Corporate Religious Diversity Assessment**. The CRDA is an internal assessment tool for companies to self-evaluate their religious diversity efforts. Using four criteria, this tool provides a solid framework for your company to evaluate its religious DEI efforts on a global
